One of the mission ministry opportunities supported by Wesley is the Kairos Prison Ministry. The Kairos Prison Ministry is a team of volunteers that present an introductory three day weekend, described as a short course in Christianity. This team of volunteers - both clergy and laypersons - work in cooperation with the Chaplain who carefully selects up to 42 inmates to attend. The mission of the Kairos Prison Ministry is to bring Christ's love and forgiveness to all incarcerated individuals, their families, and those who work with them. The next weekend in our area is scheduled for April 4-7 at the Stiles Unit.
