4 Tips for Welcoming Guests

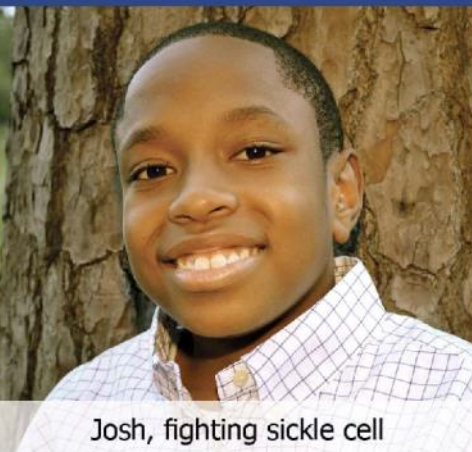
