FROM THE PASTOR

"
12 Now this is our boast: Our conscience testifies that we have conducted ourselves in the world, and especially in our relations with you, with integrity and godly sincerity. We have done so, relying not on worldly wisdom but on God's grace.

13 For we do not write you anything you cannot read or understand. And I hope that,
14 as you have understood us in part, you will come to understand fully that you can boast of us just as we will boast of you in the day of the Lord Jesus. 2

Corinthians 1: 12-14

Part of being a disciple of Jesus is making a daily commitment to following him. We often struggle to discern what the correct action to take is in moments when we are anxious or afraid. We struggle because we have to choose between our old way of doing things and the new way Jesus outlines for our life with him.

Our old way of dealing with people who have upset us or worse was to become angry, seek revenge, or distance ourselves from them and hold grudge. The new way that Christ calls us to follow is one of forgiveness, reconciliation, and seeking a just resolution to the conflict.

Paul, in his letter to the church in Corinth, reminds a group of new Christians of their new way of life and how he and those that helped him modeled it for them. While Paul and his helpers were with the new church in Corinth they conducted themselves with "integrity and godly sincerity". They did not rely on the wisdom of the world but rather relied upon God. They did this so the new Christians would "understand fully" the message of Christ and be ready for the day of the Lord.

Making a commitment to Christ also requires we commit to following him in our daily lives and obeying what he taught his disciples. We do this not only for our own salvation but also so that the message can be made clear to those who do not know him or those who are new to the faith.


