“Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.”
2 Corinthians 3: 17-18

I occasionally watch shows like American Pickers, Antique Roadshow, or one of the pawnshop shows. I know these shows are often staged, but somehow the idea of them coming across something of extraordinary value is intriguing.

They sometimes find an item whose owner is shocked to discover is of far greater worth than they ever imagined. Or an item that looks like junk is restored and looks amazingly better than you would think possible. In his letter to the church of Corinth, Paul shares that part of what God is doing in Jesus Christ is helping us discover our great worth and restoring us to the image of God.

People are sometimes surprised to discover the claim that Christians make that we are created in the image of God. Even though sin wrecks that original image, God is able to restore it in us through Jesus Christ. Over the next couple of weeks, we will celebrate what God is able to do in our lives with a sermon series entitled Restored.


